As part of your child's home learning, we feel that one of the most important parts you can play in continuing to support your child's learning is to engage in conversation about everyday activities, such as:

During meal times, sit together as a family and talk, not only about your day but the foods being eaten, the cutlery needed and allowing your child the time to set the table for the family (count the people, then the forks, knives, spoons etc needed).

Identify numbers and letters found around your home, on road signs, street names, house numbers and car numbers plates etc. Can your child spot those in their name/how old they are/the same number as your home?

Identify shapes around your home and outside. As well as identifying them, think about the features - how many sides, do they have straight or curved sides?

Explore signs of nature and the changing seasons - allow your child time to explore and enjoy being outside.

In addition to the above, the following is a guide for weekly activities which will be directed through Google Classroom:
