Formation of plural nouns

By adding -S
Example:
boy - boys

girl - girls
radio - radios
chair - chairs
book - books
bird - birds
pencil - pencils

By adding -ES
Example:
class - classes

potato - potatoes
fox - foxes
dish - dishes
match - matches
box - boxes
hero - Heroes

By changing -Y into -IES
Example:
baby - babies
lady - ladies
city - cities
fly - flies
puppy - puppies
story - stories

By changing -f or -FE into -VES
Example:

leaf - leaves
shelf - shelves
thief - thieves
half - halves
calf - calves
wolf - wolves

Irregular Plurals

Example:

man - men
tooth - teeth
foot - feet
louse - lice
woman - women
mouse - mice
goose - geese
