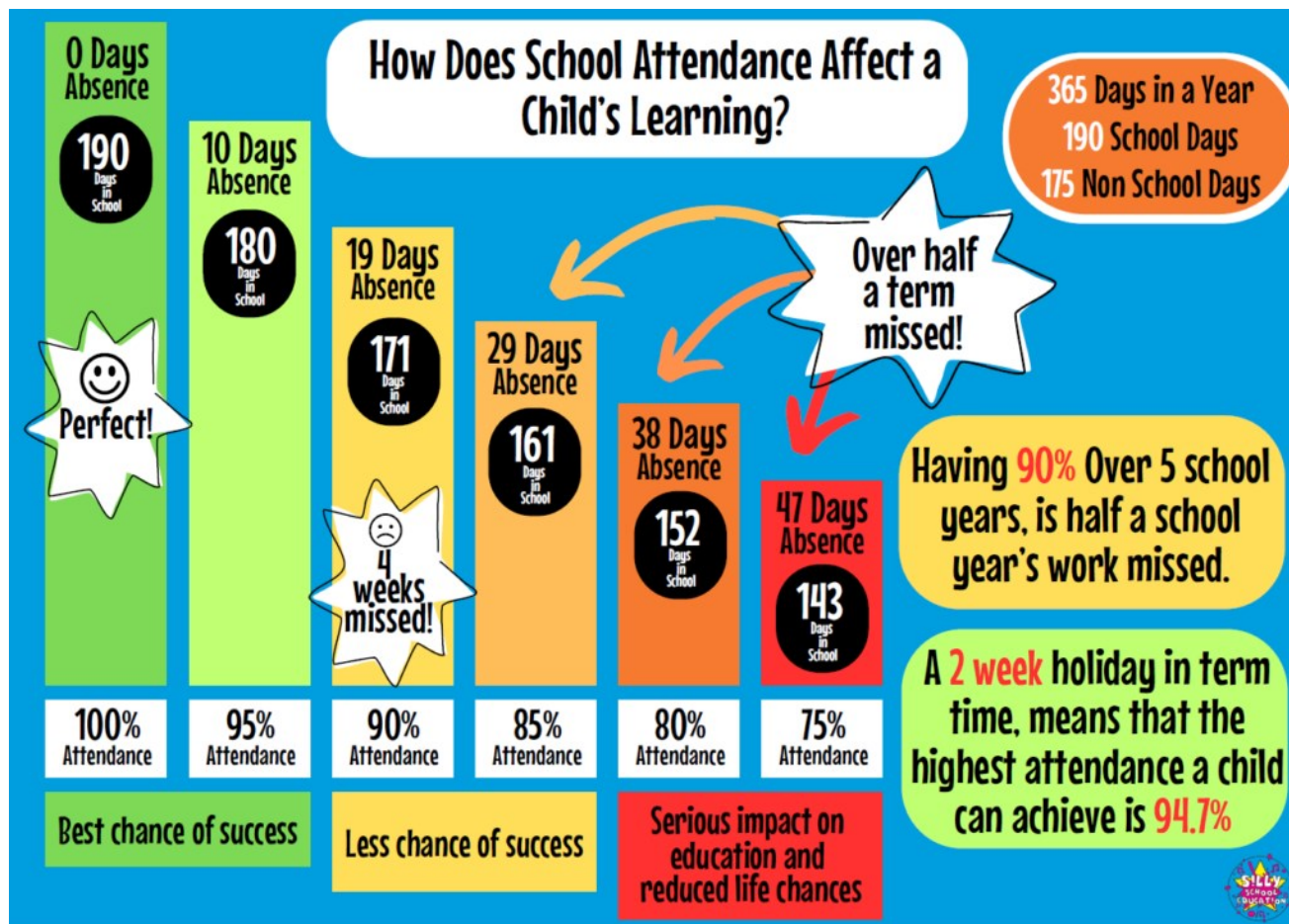

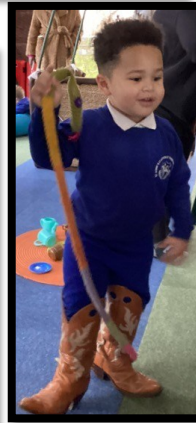
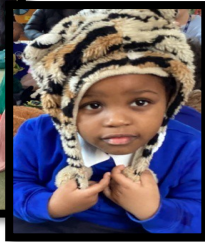

They also met with The Lord Mayor of Liverpool Councillor Richard Kemp CBE and were fantastic ambassadors for our school



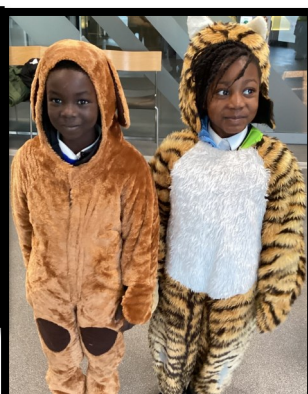
