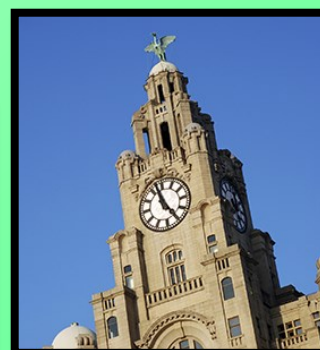
Congratulations to our Raffle Prize Winners!

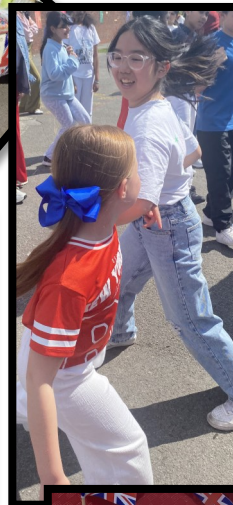
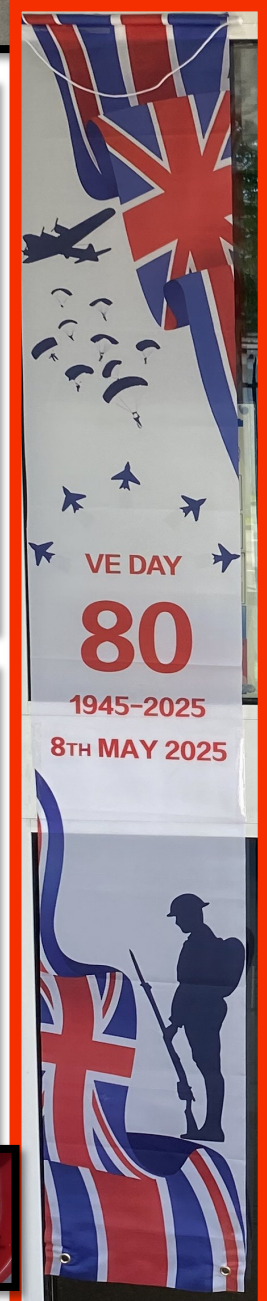
