

Y4 enjoyed the "Citizens of Earth: Music for What Matters" concert performed by the Royal Liverpool Philharmonic Orchestra earlier this month.




Year 2 delivered a wonderful assembly for parents and the rest of school showcasing their learning so far this year.




Catholic Life Every Day
