### A Caring and Nurturing Start

We believe that children's first experiences of education should be positive, secure and inspiring. Our staff work hard to build strong relationships with every child and family, creating an environment where children feel confident, happy and ready to learn.

### Our Nursery Provision

Children can join our Nursery from the term after their third birthday.

From September 2026, our Nursery will offer 15 funded hours each week through the following sessions:

- **Monday:** 8:45am – 3:15pm
- **Tuesday:** 8:45am – 3:15pm
- **Wednesday:** 8:45am – 11:45am



Children attending the full-day sessions will bring a packed lunch and enjoy extended opportunities for learning, play and social development throughout the day.

This structure provides several benefits for families and children, including:

- Greater flexibility through two full-day sessions each week.
- Fewer daily drop-offs and collections.
- Longer periods of uninterrupted learning and play.
- Enhanced opportunities to build friendships and social skills.
- Increased independence and readiness for Reception.

### **High Expectations for Every Child**

At St Anne's, inclusion is at the heart of everything we do. We believe every child can succeed and we provide support quickly when it is needed, while maintaining high expectations for all learners.

Our curriculum is carefully planned to help children build knowledge and skills step by step. Ofsted recognised our ambitious curriculum; strong teaching and the way staff adapt learning to meet children's individual needs without lowering expectations.
