Falkner Square

Edward Falkner 1750 - 1825
 Major, High Sheriff of Lancashire and Slave Trader

Falkner Square is named after Edward Falkner a notable slave trader who invested in at least 20 voyages. Edward's father Thomas was also a prolific slaver and by the 1790s had acquired the land the square now occupies. Edward's son and namesake had the area laid out for housing after his father's death. In 1827, on the recommendation of the mayor and with the approval of the council, the square was named in commemoration of his father.

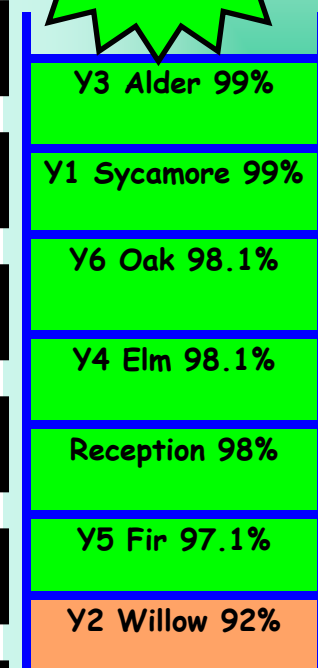

Bikeability cycle training equips children with vital life skills. Pupils not only learn to cycle, they gain independence, social skills and a sense of wellbeing.

After Bikeability, children are



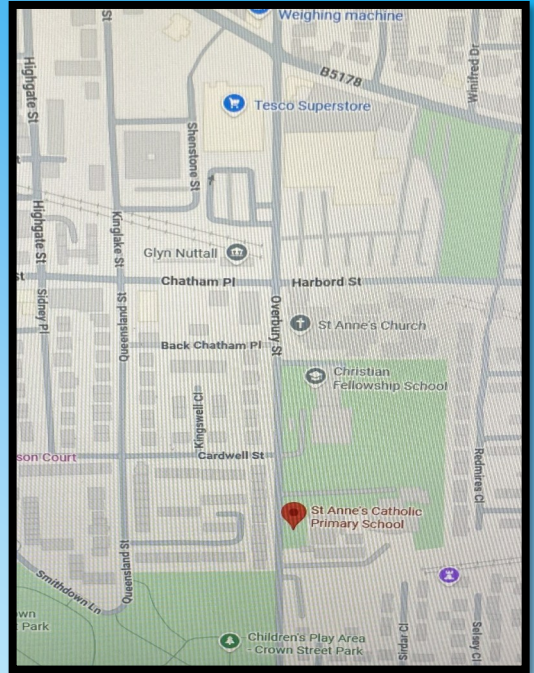
better at responding to risk and report increased confidence. As a result, more children cycle to school which in turn improves mental health and wellbeing. This allows children to get more out of the classroom, improving their attention span and engagement. Healthier habits lead to increased attendance and improved



academic results. Bikeability goes beyond a training course; it impacts children's lives.

Year 1 Local Area Walk

Last week Year 1 Sycamore class used their fieldwork skills to explore the features of our local area. We walked along Overbury Street mapping roads, houses,, a supermarket, 2 schools, a park and a church. We then created chattabboards to help us write about our findings in class.



Year 3 had a fantastic trip to the Williamson Tunnels Heritage Centre as part of our local history topic on Joseph Williamson. We explored the fascinating underground tunnels and took part in a workshop investigating artefacts discovered there, uncovering clues about Liverpool's past along the way.

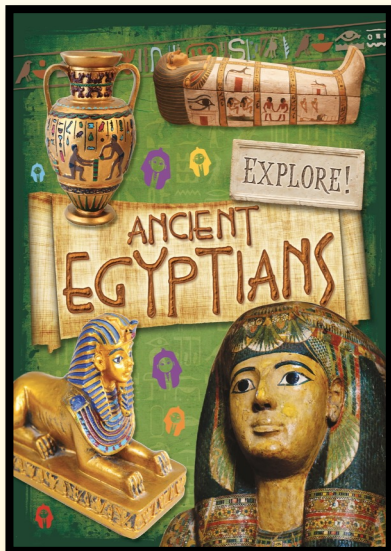
For our Year 5 Parents/Carers
